- 9 after "obtains," the following: "advertises,".
- 10 (b) Mens Rea Requirement.—Section 1591 of title
- 11 18, United States Code, is amended in subsection (a), by
- 12 inserting after "knowing, or" the following: ", except
- 13 where, in an offense under paragraph (2), the act consti-
- 14 tuting the violation of paragraph (1) is advertising,".
- 15 (c) Conforming Amendments.—Section 1591(b)
- 16 of title 18, United States Code, is amended—
- 17 (1) in paragraph (1), by striking "or obtained"
- and inserting "obtained, or advertised"; and
- 19 (2) in paragraph (2), by striking "or obtained"
- and inserting "obtained, or advertised".
