

1 **“§ 2251B. Offenses involving children**

2 “(a) OFFENSE.—Any person who commits a felony
3 offense involving a minor under section 1201, 1466A,
4 1470, 1591, 1594, 2241, 2242, 2243, 2244, 2245, 2251,
5 2251A, 2260, 2421, 2422, 2423, or 2425, within 1,000
6 feet of the real property comprising a public or private
7 elementary, vocational, or secondary school or a public or
8 private college, junior college, or university, school-spon-
9 sored activity, or a playground, or housing facility owned
10 by a public housing authority, or within 100 feet of a pub-
11 lic or private youth center, public park, public playground,
12 public swimming pool, or video arcade facility, shall be
13 sentenced to a term of imprisonment of up to 5 years in
14 addition to the imprisonment imposed for the offense
15 under that provision. The sentence imposed under this
16 section shall be consecutive to any sentence imposed for
17 the offense under that provision.

18 “(b) MINOR DEFINED.—In this section, the term
19 ‘minor’ means an individual who has not attained 18 years
20 of age.”.

21 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
22 for chapter 110 of title 18, United States Code, is amend-
23 ed by inserting after the item relating to section 2251A
24 the following new item:

“2251B. Offenses involving children.”.
