A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Transportation to modify certain regulations relating to the requirements for commercial driver's license testing and commercial learner's permit holders, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Licensing Individual
5 Commercial Exam-takers Now Safely and Efficiently Act
6 of 2023” or the “LICENSE Act of 2023”.

7 **SEC. 2. MODIFICATIONS TO CERTAIN COMMERCIAL DRIV-**
8 **ER’S LICENSE REGULATIONS.**

9 Not later than 90 days after the date of enactment
10 of this Act, the Secretary of Transportation, acting
11 through the Administrator of the Federal Motor Carrier
12 Safety Administration, shall—

13 (1) revise section 384.228 of title 49, Code of
14 Federal Regulations (or a successor regulation), to
15 allow a State or third-party examiner to administer
16 the commercial driver’s license knowledge test only
17 if the examiner—

18 (A) maintains a valid commercial driver’s
19 license test examiner certification;

20 (B) completes a commercial driver’s license
21 skills test examiner training course that meets
22 the requirements of subsection (d) of such sec-
23 tion; and

24 (C) completes 1 unit of instruction de-
25 scribed in subsection (c)(3) of such section; and

1 (2) revise section 383.79 of title 49, Code of
2 Federal Regulations (or a successor regulation), to
3 allow a State to administer a driving skills tests to
4 any commercial driver's license applicant, regardless
5 of the State of domicile of the applicant or where the
6 applicant received driver training.
