# **A BILL**

To allow Federal law enforcement officers to purchase retired service weapons, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 *This Act may be cited as the “Federal Law Enforce-*  
5 *ment Officer Service Weapon Purchase Act”.*

6 **SEC. 2. PURCHASE OF RETIRED HANDGUNS BY FEDERAL**  
7 **LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS.**

8 *(a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 1 year after the date*  
9 *of enactment of this Act, the Administrator of General Serv-*  
10 *ices shall establish a program under which a Federal law*  
11 *enforcement officer may purchase a retired handgun from*  
12 *the Federal agency that issued the handgun to such officer.*

13 *(b) LIMITATIONS.—A Federal law enforcement officer*  
14 *may purchase a retired handgun under subsection (a) if—*

15 *(1) the purchase is made during the six-month*  
16 *period beginning on the date the handgun was so re-*  
17 *tired; and*

18 *(2) with respect to such purchase, the officer is*  
19 *in good standing with the Federal agency that em-*  
20 *ploys such officer.*

21 *(c) COST.—A handgun purchased under this section*  
22 *shall be sold at the fair market value for such handgun tak-*  
23 *ing into account the age and condition of the handgun.*

24 *(d) DEFINITIONS.—In this section—*

1           (1) *the term “Federal law enforcement officer”*  
2           *has the meaning given that term in section 115(c)(1)*  
3           *of title 18, United States Code;*

4           (2) *the term “handgun” has the meaning given*  
5           *that term in section 921(a) of title 18, United States*  
6           *Code; and*

7           (3) *the term “retired handgun” means any*  
8           *handgun that has been declared surplus by the appli-*  
9           *cable agency.*
