- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-

1	SECTION 1. EXEMPTION FROM PROHIBITIONS FOR ALAS-
2	KAN NATIVE ARTICLES CONTAINING MIGRA
3	TORY BIRD PARTS.
4	Section 2 of the Migratory Bird Treaty Act (16
5	U.S.C. 703) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
6	lowing:
7	"(c) Exemption for Authentic Alaskan Native
8	ARTICLES OF HANDICRAFT OR CLOTHING.—
9	"(1) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other
10	provisions of this Act, nothing in this Act prohibits
11	possession, offering for sale, sale, offering to barter
12	barter, offering to purchase, purchase, delivery for
13	shipment, shipment, causing to be shipped, delivered
14	for transportation, transport or causing to be trans-
15	ported, carrying or causing to be carried, or receiv-
16	ing for shipment, transportation, or carriage, any
17	authentic Alaskan Native article of handicraft or
18	clothing on the basis that it contains a nonedible mi-
19	gratory bird part.
20	"(2) Limitation.—This subsection shall not
21	apply with respect to any handicraft or clothing con-
22	taining any part of a migratory bird that was taken
23	in a wasteful manner.
24	"(3) Definitions.—In this subsection:

1	"(A) Alaskan native.—The term 'Alas-
2	kan Native' means any Indian, Aleut, or Es-
3	kimo who resides in Alaska.
4	"(B) AUTHENTIC ALASKAN NATIVE ARTI-
5	CLE OF HANDICRAFT OR CLOTHING.—The term
6	'authentic Alaskan Native article of handicraft
7	or clothing'—
8	"(i) means any item that is—
9	"(I) composed wholly or in some
10	significant respect of natural mate-
11	rials; and
12	"(II) produced, decorated, or
13	fashioned by an Alaskan Native, in
14	the exercise of traditional Alaskan
15	Native handicrafts, without the use of
16	any pantograph or other mass copying
17	device; and
18	"(ii) includes any weaving, carving,
19	stitching, sewing, lacing, beading, drawing,

or painting described in clause (i), or any combination thereof.".
