To provide that inclined sleepers for infants and crib bumpers shall be considered banned hazardous products under section 8 of the Consumer Product Safety Act, and for other purposes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

- This Act may be cited as the "Safe Sleep for Babies
- 3 Act of 2021".

4 SEC. 2. BANNING OF INCLINED SLEEPERS FOR INFANTS.

- 5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
- 6 date of enactment of this Act, inclined sleepers for infants,
- 7 regardless of the date of manufacture, shall be considered
- 8 a banned hazardous product under section 8 of the Con-
- 9 sumer Product Safety Act (15 U.S.C. 2057).
- 10 (b) Inclined Sleeper for Infants Defined.—
- 11 In this section, the term "inclined sleeper for infants"
- 12 means a product with an inclined sleep surface greater
- 13 than ten degrees that is intended, marketed, or designed
- 14 to provide sleeping accommodations for an infant up to
- 15 1 year old.

16 SEC. 3. BANNING OF CRIB BUMPERS.

- 17 (a) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 180 days after the
- 18 date of enactment of this Act, crib bumpers, regardless
- 19 of the date of manufacture, shall be considered a banned
- 20 hazardous product under section 8 of the Consumer Prod-
- 21 uct Safety Act (15 U.S.C. 2057).
- 22 (b) Crib Bumper Defined.—In this section, the
- 23 term "crib bumper"—
- (1) means any material that is intended to
- cover the sides of a crib to prevent injury to any crib
- occupant from impacts against the side of a crib or

1	to prevent partial or complete access to any openings
2	in the sides of a crib to prevent a crib occupant from
3	getting any part of the body entrapped in any open-
4	ing;
5	(2) includes a padded crib bumper, a supported
6	and unsupported vinyl bumper guard, and vertical
7	crib slat covers; and
8	(3) does not include a non-padded mesh crib
9	liner.
