## A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to make permanent the authority of the Secretary of Veterans Affairs to provide financial assistance for supportive services for very low-income veteran families in permanent housing.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Supporting Veteran  
5 Families in Need Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. PERMANENT AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL**  
2 **ASSISTANCE FOR SUPPORTIVE SERVICES**  
3 **FOR VERY LOW-INCOME VETERAN FAMILIES**  
4 **IN PERMANENT HOUSING.**

5 Section 2044(e) of title 38, United States Code, is  
6 amended—

7 (1) by redesignating subparagraphs (A) through  
8 (H) as paragraphs (1) through (8), respectively; and

9 (2) by adding at the end the following new  
10 paragraph:

11 “(9) The amounts that are appropriated to  
12 carry out such subsections for fiscal year 2025 and  
13 each fiscal year thereafter.”.
