A BILL

2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Demilitarizing Local
5 Law Enforcement Act of 2021”.

6 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF DEPARTMENT OF DEFENSE SUPPORT**
7 **TO LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Chapter 153 of title 10, United
9 States Code, is amended by striking section 2576a.

1 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
2 at the beginning of such chapter is amended by striking
3 the item relating to section 2576a.
