A BILL

To require the Assistant Secretary of Commerce for Communications and Information to report to Congress on any barriers to establishing online portals to accept, process, and dispose of certain Form 299s, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Facilitating the De-
5 ployment of Infrastructure with Greater Internet Trans-
6 actions And Legacy Applications Act” or the “Facilitating
7 DIGITAL Applications Act”.

8 **SEC. 2. REPORT ON BARRIERS TO ESTABLISHING ONLINE**
9 **PORATAKS TO ACCEPT, PROCESS, AND DIS-**
10 **POSE OF CERTAIN FORM 299s.**

11 (a) REPORT.—

12 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after
13 the date of the enactment of this section, and every
14 60 days thereafter until the Secretaries concerned
15 each notify the Assistant Secretary under paragraph
16 (2), the Assistant Secretary shall submit to the ap-
17 propriate congressional committees a report that de-
18 scribes—

19 (A) whether the Secretaries concerned have
20 established, with respect to the relevant covered
21 department, an online portal for the acceptance,
22 processing, and disposal of a Form 299 for
23 communications use authorization; and

24 (B) any barrier to the establishment of any
25 such portal.

1 (2) NOTIFICATION.—Not later than 3 business
2 days after the date on which the online portal has
3 been established by a Secretary pursuant to para-
4 graph (1), that Secretary shall notify the Assistant
5 Secretary of the establishment of such portal.

6 (b) DEFINITIONS.—In this Act:

7 (1) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL COMMIT-
8 TEES.—The term “appropriate congressional com-
9 mittees” means—

10 (A) the Committee on Energy and Com-
11 mmerce of the House of Representatives;

12 (B) the Committee on Natural Resources
13 of the House of Representatives;

14 (C) the Committee on Commerce, Science,
15 and Transportation of the Senate; and

16 (D) the Committee on Environment and
17 Public Works of the Senate.

18 (2) ASSISTANT SECRETARY.—The term “Assist-
19 ant Secretary” means the Assistant Secretary of
20 Commerce for Communications and Information.

21 (3) COMMUNICATIONS FACILITY.—The term
22 “communications facility” has the meaning given the
23 term “communications facility installation” in sec-
24 tion 6409(d) of the Middle Class Tax Relief and Job
25 Creation Act of 2012 (47 U.S.C. 1455(d)).

1 (4) COMMUNICATIONS USE.—The term “communications use” means the placement and operation of a communications facility.

4 (5) COMMUNICATIONS USE AUTHORIZATION.—
5 The term “communications use authorization”
6 means an easement, right-of-way, lease, license, or
7 other authorization—

8 (A) provided by the Secretary of the Interior or the Secretary of Agriculture;

10 (B) to locate or modify a communications facility on covered land; and

12 (C) for the primary purpose of authorizing the occupancy and use of such covered land for communications use.

15 (6) COVERED LAND.—The term “covered land” means—

17 (A) public lands; and

18 (B) National Forest System land.

19 (7) FORM 299.—The term “Form 299” means the form established under section 6409(b)(2)(A) of the Middle Class Tax Relief and Job Creation Act of 2012 (47 U.S.C. 1455(b)(2)(A)), or any successor form.

24 (8) NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM.—The term “National Forest System” has the meaning given

1 that term in section 11(a) of the Forest and Range-
2 land Renewable Resources Planning Act of 1974 (16
3 U.S.C. 1609(a)).

4 (9) RELEVANT COVERED DEPARTMENT.—The
5 term “relevant covered department” means—

6 (A) with respect to the Secretary of the In-
7 terior, the Department of the Interior; and
8 (B) with respect to the Secretary of Agri-
9 culture, the Department of Agriculture.

10 (10) SECRETARY CONCERNED.—The term
11 “Secretary concerned” means—

12 (A) the Secretary of the Interior; and
13 (B) the Secretary of Agriculture, acting
14 through the Chief of the Forest Service.

20 **SEC. 2. REPORT ON BARRIERS TO ESTABLISHING ONLINE
21 PORTALS TO ACCEPT, PROCESS, AND DIS-
22 POSE OF CERTAIN FORM 299s.**

23 (a) REPORT.—

24 (1) IN GENERAL.—Not later than 90 days after
25 the date of the enactment of this section, and every 60

1 *days thereafter until the Secretaries concerned each*
2 *notify the Assistant Secretary under paragraph (2),*
3 *the Assistant Secretary shall submit to the appro-*
4 *priate congressional committees a report that de-*
5 *scribes—*

6 *(A) whether the Secretaries concerned have*
7 *established, with respect to the relevant covered*
8 *department, an online portal for the acceptance,*
9 *processing, and disposal of a Form 299 for com-*
10 *munications use authorization;*

11 *(B) any barrier to the establishment of any*
12 *such portal; and*

13 *(C) whether the online portal described in*
14 *subparagraph (A) is consistent with—*

15 *(i) the priorities identified in section*
16 *110 of the National Environmental Policy*
17 *Act of 1969 (42 U.S.C. 4336d); and*

18 *(ii) the results of the study required*
19 *under that section with respect to any per-*
20 *mit that requires review under that Act.*

21 *(2) NOTIFICATION.—Not later than 3 business*
22 *days after the date on which the online portal has*
23 *been established by a Secretary pursuant to para-*
24 *graph (1), that Secretary shall notify the Assistant*
25 *Secretary of the establishment of such portal.*

1 (b) *DEFINITIONS.*—In this Act:

12 *Public Works of the Senate.*

13 (2) *ASSISTANT SECRETARY.*—The term “Assist-
14 ant Secretary” means the Assistant Secretary of Com-
15 merce for Communications and Information.

16 (3) *COMMUNICATIONS FACILITY.*—The term
17 “communications facility” has the meaning given the
18 term “communications facility installation” in sec-
19 tion 6409(d) of the Middle Class Tax Relief and Job
20 Creation Act of 2012 (47 U.S.C. 1455(d)).

21 (4) *COMMUNICATIONS USE.*—The term “commu-
22 nications use” means the placement and operation of

22 *Renewable Resources Planning Act of 1974 (16*
23 *U.S.C. 1609(a)).*

24 *(9) RELEVANT COVERED DEPARTMENT.—The*
25 *term “relevant covered department” means—*

1 (A) *with respect to the Secretary of the Inter-*
2 *prior, the Department of the Interior; and*

3 (B) *with respect to the Secretary of Agri-*
4 *culture, the Department of Agriculture.*

5 (10) *SECRETARY CONCERNED.*—*The term “Sec-*
6 *retary concerned” means—*

7 (A) *the Secretary of the Interior; and*

8 (B) *the Secretary of Agriculture, acting*
9 *through the Chief of the Forest Service.*

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
