## A BILL

To amend title 31, United States Code, to exempt expenditures or obligations of funds derived from user fees from certain limitations under the Antideficiency Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Fiduciary Responsi-  
5 bility and Fairness Act of 2013”.

1 **SEC. 2. EXEMPTION FOR EXPENDITURES OR OBLIGATIONS**  
2 **OF FUNDS DERIVED FROM USER FEES.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 1341(a) of title 31,  
4 United States Code, is amended by adding at the end the  
5 following:

6 “(3) This subsection does not apply in the case  
7 of any expenditure or obligation of funds derived  
8 from user fees and authorized to be appropriated for  
9 such purpose.”.

10 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by  
11 subsection (a) shall apply with respect to expenditures and  
12 obligations made or authorized after the date of the enact-  
13 ment of this Act.
