# H. R. 3419

To amend the Animal Health Protection Act to reauthorize the animal disease prevention and management programs.

Mr. JACKSON of Texas (for himself, Ms. CRAIG, Mr. BACON, Mr. DAVIS of North Carolina, and Mr. COSTA) introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Agriculture

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## A BILL

To amend the Animal Health Protection Act to reauthorize the animal disease prevention and management programs.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Foreign Animal Dis-  
5 ease Prevention, Surveillance, and Rapid Response Act of  
6 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF ANIMAL DISEASE PREVEN-**  
2 **TION AND MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS.**

3 (a) MANDATORY FUNDING.—Section 10409A(d)(1)  
4 of the Animal Health Protection Act (7 U.S.C.  
5 8308a(d)(1)) is amended to read as follows:

6 “(1) MANDATORY FUNDING.—

7 “(A) FISCAL YEARS 2024 THROUGH 2028.—

8 Of the funds of the Commodity Credit Corpora-  
9 tion, the Secretary shall make available to carry  
10 out this section \$233,000,000 for each of fiscal  
11 years 2024 through 2028, of which—

12 “(i) not less than \$10,000,000 shall  
13 be made available for each such fiscal year  
14 to carry out subsection (a);

15 “(ii) not less than \$70,000,000 shall  
16 be made available for each such fiscal year  
17 to carry out subsection (b); and

18 “(iii) not less than \$153,000,000 shall  
19 be made available for each such fiscal year  
20 to carry out subsection (c).

21 “(B) SUBSEQUENT FISCAL YEARS.—Of the  
22 funds of the Commodity Credit Corporation, the  
23 Secretary shall make available to carry out this  
24 section \$30,000,000 for fiscal year 2029 and  
25 each fiscal year thereafter, of which not less  
26 than \$18,000,000 shall be made available for

1 each of those fiscal years to carry out sub-  
2 section (b).”.

3 (b) AUTHORIZATION OF APPROPRIATIONS.—

4 (1) NATIONAL ANIMAL HEALTH LABORA-  
5 TORY.—Section 10409A(d)(2)(A) of the Animal  
6 Health Protection Act (7 U.S.C. 8308a(d)(2)(A)) is  
7 amended—

8 (A) by striking “\$30,000,000” and insert-  
9 ing “\$45,000,000”; and

10 (B) by striking “2019 through 2023” and  
11 inserting “2024 through 2028”.

12 (2) NATIONAL ANIMAL DISEASE PREPAREDNESS  
13 AND RESPONSE PROGRAM; NATIONAL ANIMAL VAC-  
14 CINE AND VETERINARY COUNTERMEASURES  
15 BANK.—Section 10409A(d)(2)(B) of the Animal  
16 Health Protection Act (7 U.S.C. 8308a(d)(2)(B)) is  
17 amended by striking “2019 through 2023” and in-  
18 serting “2024 through 2028”.

19 (c) AVAILABILITY AND PURPOSE OF FUNDING.—Sec-  
20 tion 10409A(e)(1) of the Animal Health Protection Act  
21 (7 U.S.C. 8308a(e)(1)) is amended by striking “2019  
22 through 2023” and inserting “2024 through 2028”.

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
