1	SECTION 1. PAYMENT OF NON-FEDERAL SHARE OF
2	PROJECTS IN MEXICO AND CANADA UNDER
3	NORTH AMERICAN WETLANDS CONSERVA
4	TION ACT.
5	(a) In General.—Section 8(b)(3) of the North
6	American Wetlands Conservation Act (16 U.S.C
7	4407(b)(3)) is amended to read as follows:
8	"(3) The non-Federal share of the United States con-
9	tribution to the costs of such projects may not be derived
10	from Federal grant programs. In the case of a project car-
11	ried out in Canada or Mexico, the non-Federal share or
12	the costs of the project may include cash contributions
13	from non-United States sources that are used to pay costs
14	of the project. In the case of a project carried out in Can-
15	ada, funds from Canadian sources may comprise up to 50
16	percent of the non-Federal share of the costs of the
17	project.".
18	(b) APPLICATION.—The amendment made by sub-
19	section (a) shall apply with respect to any approved and
20	active wetlands conservation project (as that term is used
21	in section 8(b)(1) of such Act) carried out with assistance
22	provided under such Act, including such a project ap-
23	proved before the date of the enactment of this Act.
