## A BILL

To amend the Food Security Act of 1985 to increase funding for the conservation stewardship program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. ANNUAL FUNDING.**

4 Section 1241(a)(3)(B) of the Food Security Act of  
5 1985 (16 U.S.C. 3841(a)(3)(B)) is amended to read as  
6 follows:

7 “(B) for the conservation stewardship pro-  
8 gram under subchapter B of that chapter,

1           \$1,800,000,000 for each of fiscal years 2024  
2           through 2031.”.

3 **SEC. 2. TRANSFER OF FUNDS.**

4           \$5,020,000,000 of the unobligated balances of  
5 amount appropriated or otherwise made available under  
6 section 21001 of Public Law 117–169 (commonly referred  
7 to as the Inflation Reduction Act of 2022) is hereby  
8 transferred to the Secretary of Agriculture to carry out,  
9 using the facilities and authorities of the Commodity Cred-  
10 it Corporation, the conservation stewardship program  
11 under subchapter B of chapter 4 of subtitle D of title XII  
12 of the Food Security Act of 1985 (16 U.S.C. 3839aa–21  
13 et seq.).
