Mr. CHABOT introduced the following bill; which was referred to the  
Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure

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## A BILL

To terminate the Denali Commission, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Eliminate the Commis-  
5       sion to Nowhere Act of 2013”.

6       **SEC. 2. TERMINATION OF DENALI COMMISSION.**

7       (a) **TERMINATION.**—The Denali Commission is ter-  
8       minated.

9       (b) **TRANSFERS.**—The authority of any Federal de-  
10       partment or agency to transfer funds to the Denali Com-  
11       mission shall cease to be effective.

12       (c) **REPEALS.**—

1           (1) The Denali Commission Act of 1998 (42  
2           U.S.C. 3121 note) is repealed.

3           (2) Section 329(b) of division A of Public Law  
4           105–277 (112 Stat. 2681–470(b)) is repealed.

5           (d) CONCLUSION OF BUSINESS.—The Secretary of  
6 Commerce shall take such actions as may be necessary  
7 and appropriate to conclude the outstanding affairs of the  
8 Denali Commission, including dispositions of personnel,  
9 assets, and obligations.

10          (e) LIMITATION ON STATUTORY CONSTRUCTION.—  
11 This section may not be construed to prevent the expendi-  
12 ture of any funds received before the effective date of this  
13 Act. Such funds shall be subject to the laws and regula-  
14 tions that would have applied to the funds if this section  
15 had not been enacted.

16 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

17          This Act shall take effect on the first day of the first  
18 fiscal year beginning after the date of enactment of this  
19 Act.

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
