1 **SECTION 1. NATIONAL CLANDESTINE SERVICE OF THE**
2 **CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE AGENCY NCS OFFI-**
3 **CER GREGG DAVID WENZEL MEMORIAL POST**
4 **OFFICE.**

5 (a) DESIGNATION.—The facility of the United States
6 Postal Service located at 787 State Route 17M in Monroe,
7 New York, shall be known and designated as the “Na-
8 tional Clandestine Service of the Central Intelligence
9 Agency NCS Officer Gregg David Wenzel Memorial Post
10 Office”.

11 (b) REFERENCES.—Any reference in a law, map, reg-
12 ulation, document, paper, or other record of the United
13 States to the facility referred to in subsection (a) shall
14 be deemed to be a reference to the “National Clandestine
15 Service of the Central Intelligence Agency NCS Officer
16 Gregg David Wenzel Memorial Post Office”.
