 - 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
 - 4 This Act may be cited as the "Permanently Pro-
 - 5 tecting Tenants at Foreclosure Act of 2011".
 - 6 SEC. 2. REPEAL OF SUNSET PROVISION.
 - 7 Section 704 of the Protecting Tenants at Foreclosure
 - 8 Act of 2009 (12 U.S.C. 5201 note; 12 U.S.C. 5220 note;
 - 9 42 U.S.C. 1437f note) is hereby repealed.

1 SEC. 3. PRIVATE RIGHT OF ACTION.

- 2 The Protecting Tenants at Foreclosure Act of 2009,
- 3 as amended by section 2 of this Act, is further amended
- 4 by adding at the end the following new section:

5 "SEC. 704. PRIVATE RIGHT OF ACTION.

- 6 "(a) RIGHT OF ACTION.—Any person aggrieved by
- 7 a violation referred to in subsection (b) may bring a civil
- 8 action in a court of competent jurisdiction for damages
- 9 resulting from such violation, and may obtain other appro-
- 10 priate relief, including equitable relief. If the plaintiff pre-
- 11 vails in any such action, the court shall award the plaintiff
- 12 any litigation costs reasonably incurred, together with rea-
- 13 sonable attorneys' fees and reasonable expert witness fees,
- 14 as determined by the court.
- 15 "(b) VIOLATION.—A violation referred to in this sub-
- 16 section is a violation of—
- 17 "(1) section 702 of this title; or
- 18 "(2) the matter in subparagraph (C) or (F) of
- section 8(o)(7) of the United States Housing Act of
- 20 1937 (42 U.S.C. 1437f(o)(7)) that was added by the
- amendments made by section 703 of this title".

C
