## A BILL

To prohibit the availability of Federal funds to the World Health Organization pending the conduct of an investigation relating to the influence over such organization by Chinese Communist Party, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*

2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. PROHIBITION ON FEDERAL FUNDING TO**

4                   **WORLD HEALTH ORGANIZATION PENDING IN-**

5                   **VESTIGATION.**

6       (a) PROHIBITION.—Notwithstanding any other provi-

7       sion of law, no Federal funds may be made available, di-

1 rectly or indirectly, to the World Health Organization  
2 until the President—

3 (1) conducts an investigation, with the compli-  
4 ance of the Director-General of the World Health  
5 Organization, to assess and determine the level of  
6 influence by the Chinese Communist Party over the  
7 operations of the World Health Organization (in-  
8 cluding with respect to influence regarding the ori-  
9 gin of COVID–19 and any coverup relating to such  
10 origin); and

11 (2) submits to the appropriate congressional re-  
12 cipients a report containing the findings of such in-  
13 vestigation.

14 (b) APPROPRIATE CONGRESSIONAL RECIPIENTS DE-  
15 FINED.—In this section, the term “appropriate congres-  
16 sional recipients” means—

17 (1) the Committee on the Judiciary and the  
18 Committee on Ways and Means of the House of  
19 Representatives;

20 (2) the Committee on the Judiciary and the  
21 Committee on Finance of the Senate;

22 (3) the Speaker and minority leader of the  
23 House of Representatives; and

1                   (4) the majority leader and minority leader of  
2                   the Senate.
