1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXPANSION OF ELIGIBILITY FOR MEDALLIONS.**

4 Section 2306(d)(4) of title 38, United States Code,
5 is amended by adding at the end the following sentence:

6 “Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the Sec-
7 retary may furnish a medallion or other device under this
8 paragraph regardless of the date of the death of the indi-

1 vidual for whom the medallion or other device is fur-
2 nished.”.
