2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. EXPANDING ELIGIBILITY FOR CERTAIN CON-**
4 **TRACTS.**

5 (a) COMPETITIVE THRESHOLDS.—Section 8020 of
6 title VIII of division A of the Department of Defense,
7 Emergency Supplemental Appropriations to Address Hur-
8 ricanes in the Gulf of Mexico, and Pandemic Influenza
9 Act, 2006 (15 U.S.C. 637 note) is amended by striking
10 “with agencies of the Department of Defense” and insert-

1 ing “with agencies and departments of the Federal Gov-
2 ernment”.

3 (b) RULEMAKING.—Not later than 180 days after the
4 date of enactment of this Act, in order to carry out the
5 amendments made by subsection (a)—

6 (1) the Administrator of the Small Business
7 Administration, in consultation with the Adminis-
8 trator for Federal Procurement Policy, shall promul-
9 gate regulations; and

10 (2) the Federal Acquisition Regulatory Council
11 established under section 1302(a) of title 41, United
12 States Code, shall amend the Federal Acquisition
13 Regulation.
