A BILL

To require the Secretary of Transportation to provide funds to address motor vehicle safety and impaired driving, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Combatting Impaired
5 Driving Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY AND IMPAIRED DRIVING.**

7 (a) **AUTHORIZATION OF FUNDS.**—The Secretary of
8 Transportation shall provide funding for grants, pilot pro-
9 gram activities, demonstration projects, and innovative so-
10 lutions to improve motor vehicle safety, as defined in sec-

1 tion 30102 of title 49, United States Code, to address im-
2 paired driving, including alcohol, marijuana, and opioid-
3 impaired driving.

4 (b) FUNDING AMOUNT.—There is authorized to be
5 appropriated to the Secretary to carry out subsection (a),
6 amounts as follows:

- 7 (1) \$7,000,000 for fiscal year 2021.
8 (2) \$9,000,000 for fiscal year 2022.
9 (3) \$9,000,000 for fiscal year 2023.
10 (4) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 2024.
11 (5) \$10,000,000 for fiscal year 2025.
