## A BILL

To amend the Food, Agriculture, Conservation, and Trade Act of 1990 to reauthorize the Genome to Phenome Initiative, and for other purposes.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4       This Act may be cited as the “Genome to Phenome  
5       Initiative Reauthorization Act of 2023” or the “AG2PI  
6       Act of 2023”.

7       **SEC. 2. FINDINGS.**

8       Congress finds the following:

9              (1) Understanding crop and livestock genomes  
10          (genes) and phenomes (traits) has been a significant

1 roadblock in converting what we know about genetics  
2 into useful improvements in agriculturally important species.  
3

4 (2) Significant research is needed to fully characterize phenomes and how these plant and livestock  
5 traits relate to genes, disease resilience, and environmental factors.  
6  
7

8 (3) This information will help farmers and ranchers determine the best combinations of genetics  
9 and management practices to improve the resilience,  
10 productivity, and profitability of their businesses.  
11

12 (4) Reauthorization of the Genome to Phenome Initiative to build on the work of the Agriculture Improvement Act of 2018 (Public Law 115–334) is critical.

15 (5) In addition, reauthorization will help support a broad network of researchers, including data scientists, engineers, agricultural economists, and social scientists, and will help develop the most promising of the new concepts generated via the seed grant program into full-fledged research projects.

18 (6) These efforts will ultimately promote efficient and sustainable agricultural production systems under current as well as future climactic conditions.

1   **SEC. 3. REAUTHORIZATION OF GENOME TO PHENOME INITIATIVE.**

3           Section 1671(f) of the Food, Agriculture, Conserva-

5   ed by striking “2023” and inserting “2028”.
