# A BILL

To provide for the issuance of a veterans health care stamp.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

### **3** SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

4 This Act may be cited as the "Veterans Health Care5 Stamp Act".

#### 6 SEC. 2. VETERANS HEALTH CARE STAMP.

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—In order to afford a convenient8 way for members of the public to contribute to funding

for the medical care and treatment of veterans, the United
 States Postal Service shall provide for the issuance and
 sale of a special postage stamp, hereinafter referred to as
 the "veterans health care stamp", in accordance with sub sections (b) and (c).

- 6 (b) TERMS AND CONDITIONS.—The issuance and sale
  7 of the veterans health care stamp shall be governed by
  8 section 416 of title 39, United States Code, except that—
- 9 (1) all amounts becoming available from the 10 sale of such stamp shall be transferred to the De-11 partment of Veterans Affairs in accordance with sec-12 tion 416(d) of such title; and
- 13 (2) such stamp shall not be subject to any nu14 merical limitation under section 416(e)(1)(C) of
  15 such title.

(c) ANNUAL REISSUANCE.—The veterans health care
stamp shall bear such illustration, depiction, or other
image or design as the Postal Service shall determine in
time to allow for its reissuance to coincide with Veterans
Day of each year.
