5 Section 4683(a) of title 10, United States Code, is
6 amended by adding at the end the following new para7 graph:

8 "(3) In order to meet the needs of an eligible organi-9 zation with respect to performing funeral and other cere-10 monies, if the Secretary determines appropriate, the Sec-11 retary may—

12 "(A) loan or donate excess small arms to an eli-13 gible organization;

14 "(B) authorize an eligible organization to retain
15 small arms other than M-1 rifles; or

"(C) if excess small arms stock is insufficient to
meet organizational requirements, prescribe policies
and procedures to establish a rotational loan program based on the needs of eligible organizations.".
