1 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

2 This Act may be cited as the “Food Access and Sta-
3 bility Act of 2023”.

4 **SEC. 2. AMENDMENT.**

5 Section 311(b)(2) of title II of division C of the Fiscal
6 Responsibility Act of 2023 (Public Law 118–5) is amend-
7 ed by striking “subsection (a)” and inserting “subsection
8 (a)(1)”.
