A BILL

To amend the SUPPORT for Patients and Communities Act to reauthorize the Recovery Housing Program.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Recovery Housing Sta-
5 bility and Support Act of 2023”.

6 **SEC. 2. REAUTHORIZATION OF THE RECOVERY HOUSING**
7 **PROGRAM.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 8071 of the SUPPORT
9 for Patients and Communities Act (42 U.S.C. 5301 note;
10 Public Law 115–271) is amended—

1 (1) by striking the section heading and insert-
2 ing “**RECOVERY HOUSING PROGRAM**”;

3 (2) in subsection (a), by striking “such sums as
4 may be necessary for each of fiscal years 2019
5 through 2023” and inserting “\$30,000,000 for each
6 of fiscal years 2024 through 2028”;

7 (3) in subsection (b)—

8 (A) in paragraph (1), by striking “not
9 later than 60 days after the date of enactment
10 of this Act” and inserting “not later than 60
11 days after the date of enactment of the Recov-
12 ery Housing Stability and Support Act of
13 2023”; and

14 (B) in paragraph (2)(B)(i)—

15 (i) in subclause (I), by striking “for
16 calendar years 2013 through 2017” and
17 inserting “for the period of 5 calendar
18 years for which there is available data, in-
19 cluding if necessary provisional data, im-
20 mediately preceding the grant cycle (which
21 shall be the period of calendar years 2018
22 through 2022 for the first grant cycle fol-
23 lowing the enactment of the Recovery
24 Housing Stability and Support Act of
25 2023)”;

1 (ii) in subclause (II), by striking “for
2 calendar years 2013 through 2017” and
3 inserting “for the period of 5 calendar
4 years for which there is available data, in-
5 cluding if necessary provisional data, im-
6 mediately preceding the grant cycle (which
7 shall be the period of calendar years 2018
8 through 2022 for the first grant cycle fol-
9 lowing the enactment of the Recovery
10 Housing Stability and Support Act of
11 2023)”; and

12 (iii) in subclause (III), by striking the
13 period at the end and inserting “for the
14 period of 5 calendar years for which there
15 is available data, including if necessary
16 provisional data, immediately preceding the
17 grant cycle (which shall be the period of
18 calendar years 2018 through 2022 for the
19 first grant cycle following the enactment of
20 the Recovery Housing Stability and Sup-
21 port Act of 2023).”; and

22 (4) in subsection (f), by striking “For the 2-
23 year period following the date of enactment of this
24 Act, the” and inserting “The”.

1 (b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of contents
2 in section 1(b) of the SUPPORT for Patients and Com-
3 munities Act (Public Law 115–271; 132 Stat. 3894) is
4 amended by striking the item relating to section 8071 and
5 inserting the following:

“Sec. 8071. Recovery Housing Program.”

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
