A BILL

To amend title 38, United States Code, to eliminate the time limitation for use of eligibility and entitlement to educational assistance under the Montgomery GI Bill.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- 4 This Act may be cited as the "Restore the Promise
- 5 GI Bill".

1	SEC. 2. ELIMINATION OF TIME LIMITATION FOR USE OF
2	ELIGIBILITY AND ENTITLEMENT TO EDU-
3	CATIONAL ASSISTANCE UNDER THE MONT-
4	GOMERY GI BILL.
5	(a) In General.—Section 3031 of chapter 30 of
6	title 38, United States Code, is amended to read as fol-
7	lows:
8	"§ 3031. Extension of entitlement to educational as-
9	sistance expiring during a quarter or se-
10	mester or after a major portion of a
11	course is complete
12	"(a) Educational Institutions Operating on
13	QUARTER OR SEMESTER SYSTEM.—If an individual eligi-
14	ble for educational assistance under this chapter is en-
15	rolled under this chapter in an educational institution reg-
16	ularly operated on the quarter or semester system and the
17	period of such individual's entitlement under this chapter
18	would, under section 3013, expire during a quarter or se-
19	mester, such period shall be extended to the end of such
20	quarter or semester.
21	"(b) OTHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS.—If an in-
22	dividual eligible for educational assistance under this
23	chapter is enrolled under this chapter in an educational
24	institution not regularly operated on the quarter or semes-
25	ter system and the period of such individual's entitlement
26	under this chapter would, under section 3013, expire after

1	a major portion of the course is completed, such period
2	shall be extended to the end of the course or for 12 weeks,
3	whichever is the lesser period of extension.".
4	(b) Clerical Amendment.—The table of sections
5	at the beginning of such chapter is amended by striking
6	the item relating to section 3031 and inserting the fol-
7	lowing new item:
	"3031. Extension of entitlement to educational assistance expiring during a quarter or semester or after a major portion of a course is complete.".
8	(c) TECHNICAL AMENDMENTS.—Such title is further
9	amended—
10	(1) in section 3018C(e)(3)(B)—
11	(A) by striking "(i) The Secretary" and in-
12	serting "The Secretary"; and
13	(B) by striking clause (ii);
14	(2) in section 3020—
15	(A) in subsection (f)(1), by striking "Sub-
16	ject to the time limitation for use of entitlement
17	under section 3031 of this title, an" and insert-
18	ing "An"; and
19	(B) in subsection (h), by striking para-
20	graph (5) and redesignating paragraphs (6) and
21	(7) as paragraphs (5) and (6), respectively; and
22	(3) in section 3321(b), by striking paragraphs
23	(1) and (2) and redesignating paragraphs (3) and
24	(4) as paragraphs (1) and (2), respectively.

- 1 (d) APPLICABILITY.—The amendment made by sub-
- 2 section (a) shall apply with respect to any person who has
- 3 been entitled to educational assistance under chapter 30
- 4 of title 38, United States Code, at any time.
- 5 (e) Outreach Requirement.—The Secretary of
- 6 Veterans Affairs shall carry out appropriate outreach ac-
- 7 tivities designed to inform veterans who may be able to
- 8 use their entitlement to educational assistance under such
- 9 chapter by reason of the amendment made by subsection
- 10 (a) of the elimination of the time limitation for the use
- 11 of such entitlement.
