## A BILL

To delay any increase in flood insurance premium rates under the National Flood Insurance Program on properties located in flood hazard areas during any re-mapping of such areas by the Federal Emergency Management Agency, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Monitoring America’s  
5 Premiums Act of 2017” or the “MAP Act of 2017”.

1 **SEC. 2. DELAY IN PREMIUM INCREASES DURING MAPPING.**

2 Subsection (e) of section 1308 of the National Flood  
3 Insurance Act of 1968 (42 U.S.C. 4015(i)) is amended—

4 (1) in paragraph (3), by striking “and” at the  
5 end;

6 (2) in paragraph (4), by striking the period at  
7 the end and inserting “; and”; and

8 (3) by adding at the end the following new  
9 paragraph:

10 “(5) in the case of any property that is located  
11 in an area having special flood hazards and for  
12 which the Administrator has commenced the process  
13 for any revision, updating, or other change in the  
14 flood insurance rate map for the property, any an-  
15 nual period during which premium rate increases  
16 would otherwise apply to such property under this  
17 title shall be tolled, and such increases suspended,  
18 during the period that begins upon the commence-  
19 ment of such process and ends upon the map becom-  
20 ing final.”.
