A BILL

To provide for the sunset of rules one year after the date on which they are finalized, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Ensuring Regulations
5 are Successful or Ended Act of 2017” or the “ERASE
6 Act of 2017”.

7 **SEC. 2. SUNSET FOR RULES.**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Except as provided in subsection
9 (b), any rule (as such term is defined in section 551 of

1 title 5, United States Code) that is finalized after the date
2 of the enactment of this Act shall sunset on the date that
3 is one year after the date on which the rule is finalized.

4 (b) CONGRESSIONAL APPROVAL.—The sunset under
5 subsection (a) shall not apply to a rule described in that
6 subsection if a joint resolution is enacted which provides
7 for the continuance of that rule.
