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## A BILL

To clarify the application of a certain provision of the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act with respect to the uniformity of pesticide labeling, consistent with the text of such Act, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Agricultural Labeling  
5 Uniformity Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. UNIFORMITY OF PESTICIDE LABELING REQUIRE-**  
2 **MENTS.**

3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 24(b) of the Federal In-  
4 secticide, Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act (7 U.S.C.  
5 136v(b)) shall be applied to require uniformity in national  
6 pesticide labeling, and prohibit any State, instrumentality  
7 or political subdivision thereof, or a court from directly  
8 or indirectly imposing or continuing in effect any require-  
9 ments for, or penalize or hold liable any entity for failing  
10 to comply with requirements with respect to, labeling or  
11 packaging that is in addition to or different from the label-  
12 ing or packaging approved by the Administrator under  
13 such Act (7 U.S.C. et seq.), including any requirements  
14 relating to warnings on such labeling or packaging.

15 (b) PROHIBITION.—The Administrator may not issue  
16 or adopt any guidance or any policy, take any regulatory  
17 action, or approve any labeling (or change to such label-  
18 ing) that is inconsistent with or in any respect different  
19 from the conclusion of—

20 (1) a human health assessment performed pur-  
21 suant to the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide, and  
22 Rodenticide Act (7 U.S.C. 136 et seq.); or

23 (2) a carcinogenicity classification for a pes-  
24 ticide performed pursuant to such Act (7 U.S.C. 136  
25 et seq.).
