A BILL

To amend the Small Business Act to require the Administrator of the Small Business Administration to provide information on regulatory changes and regulatory compliance training materials to certain entities.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Education for Con-
5 tracting Personnel Improvement Act of 2016”.

1 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT TO PROVIDE INFORMATION ON REG-**
2 **ULATORY CHANGES AND REGULATORY COM-**
3 **PLIANCE TRAINING MATERIALS TO CERTAIN**
4 **ENTITIES.**

5 Section 15 of the Small Business Act (15 U.S.C. 644)
6 is amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
7 section:

8 “(t) REGULATORY CHANGES AND TRAINING MATE-
9 RIALS.—Not less than annually, the Administrator shall
10 provide to the Defense Acquisition University (established
11 under section 1746 of title 10, United States Code), the
12 Federal Acquisition Institute (established under section
13 1201 of title 41, United States Code), the individual re-
14 sponsible for mandatory training and education of the ac-
15 quisition workforce of each agency (described under sec-
16 tion 1703(f)(1)(C) of title 41, United States Code), small
17 business development centers (as defined in section 21),
18 and entities participating in the Procurement Technical
19 Assistance Cooperative Agreement Program under chapter
20 142 of title 10, United States Code—

21 “(1) a list of all changes made in the prior year
22 to regulations promulgated—

23 “(A) by the Administrator that affect Fed-
24 eral acquisition; and

25 “(B) by the Federal Acquisition Council
26 that implement changes to this Act; and

1 “(2) any materials the Administrator has devel-
2 oped to explain, train, or assist Federal agencies or
3 departments or small business concerns to comply
4 with the regulations specified in paragraph (1).”.
