A BILL

To amend the Real ID Act of 2005 to repeal provisions requiring uniform State driver’s licenses and State identification cards, and for other purposes.

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Repeal ID Act of
5 2016”.

1 **SEC. 2. REPEAL OF REQUIREMENTS FOR UNIFORM STATE**
2 **DRIVER'S LICENSES AND STATE IDENTIFICA-**
3 **TION CARDS.**

4 (a) REPEAL.—Title II of the Real ID Act of 2005
5 (division B of Public Law 109–13) is repealed.

6 (b) CONFORMING AMENDMENTS.—

7 (1) CRIMINAL CODE.—Section 1028(a)(8) of
8 title 18, United States Code, is amended by striking
9 “false or actual authentication features” and insert-
10 ing “false identification features”.

11 (2) INTELLIGENCE REFORM AND TERRORISM
12 PREVENTION ACT OF 2004.—Section 7212 of the In-
13 telligence Reform and Terrorism Prevention Act of
14 2004 (Public Law 108–458) is amended to read as
15 it did on the day before the date of the enactment
16 of the Real ID Act of 2005.

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
