A BILL

To require the commanding general of the District of Columbia National Guard to reside in the District of Columbia.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “District of Columbia
5 National Guard Commanding General Residency Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. REQUIRING COMMANDING GENERAL OF THE DIS-**
7 **TRICT OF COLUMBIA NATIONAL GUARD RE-**
8 **SIDE IN THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA.**

9 (a) REQUIREMENT.—Section 7 of the Act entitled
10 “An Act to provide for the organization of the militia of

1 the District of Columbia, and for other purposes”, ap-
2 proved March 1, 1889 (sec. 49–301, D.C. Official Code),
3 is amended by adding at the end the following new sub-
4 section:

5 “(d) The Commanding General of the District of Co-
6 lumbia National Guard shall reside in the District of Co-
7 lumbia.”.

8 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by
9 subsection (a) shall take effect on the day that is one year
10 after the date of the enactment of this Act.
