A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to prohibit section 501(c)(3) organizations from providing funding for the administration of elections for public office.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “End Zuckerbucks Act
5 of 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. 501(C)(3) ORGANIZATIONS PROHIBITED FROM PRO-**
2 **VIDING DIRECT OR INDIRECT FUNDING FOR**
3 **ELECTION ADMINISTRATION.**

4 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal
5 Revenue Code of 1986 is amended—

6 (1) by striking “and which does not partici-
7 pate” and inserting “which does not participate”,
8 and

9 (2) by striking the period at the end and insert-
10 ing “and which does not provide direct funding to
11 any State or unit of local government for the pur-
12 pose of the administration of elections for public of-
13 fice or any funding to any State or unit of local gov-
14 ernment in a case in which it is reasonable to expect
15 such funding will be used for the purpose of the ad-
16 ministration of elections for public office (except
17 with respect to the donation of space to a State or
18 unit of local government to be used as a polling
19 place in an election for public office).”.

20 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendments made by
21 this section shall apply to funding provided in taxable
22 years beginning after December 31, 2024.

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
