Mr. BLUM introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on House Administration

## A BILL

To prohibit the use of official funds provided for the operations of a House of Congress for long-term vehicle leases, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “No Congressional Ve-  
5 hicle Leases Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. PROHIBITING USE OF CONGRESSIONAL FUNDS FOR**  
7 **LONG-TERM VEHICLE LEASES.**

8 No funds appropriated or otherwise made available  
9 during a fiscal year for the operations of a House of Con-  
10 gress, including the official and representational expenses

1 of a Member of Congress or the expenses of a committee  
2 or leadership office of a House of Congress, may be used  
3 to lease a vehicle for a period of longer than 30 consecutive  
4 days, or to lease a vehicle for a period of any length at  
5 a daily rate exceeding a maximum rate established by reg-  
6 ulation.

7 **SEC. 3. REGULATIONS.**

8 The Committee on House Administration of the  
9 House of Representatives (with respect to Representatives  
10 in, and Delegates and the Resident Commissioner to, the  
11 Congress) and the Committee on Rules and Administra-  
12 tion of the Senate (with respect to Senators) shall each  
13 promulgate such regulations as may be necessary to carry  
14 out this Act.

15 **SEC. 4. MEMBER OF CONGRESS DEFINED.**

16 In this Act, the term “Member of Congress” means  
17 a Senator or a Representative in, or Delegate or Resident  
18 Commissioner to, the Congress.

19 **SEC. 5. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

20 This Act shall apply with respect to leases entered  
21 into after the expiration of the 1-year period which begins  
22 on the date of the enactment of this Act.
