2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENTS TO THE CONTROLLED SUB-**  
4 **STANCES ACT.**

5       Section 102 of the Controlled Substances Act (21  
6 U.S.C. 802) is amended—

7           (1) by redesignating paragraph (58) as para-  
8           graph (59);

9           (2) by redesignating the second paragraph des-  
10          ignated as paragraph (57) (relating to the definition  
11          of “serious drug felony”) as paragraph (58); and

12          (3) by moving paragraphs (57), (58) (as so re-  
13          designated), and (59) (as so redesignated) 2 ems to  
14          the left.
