## A BILL

To amend the Public Health Service Act to authorize the use of Preventive Health and Health Services Block Grants to purchase life-saving opioid antagonists for schools and to provide related training and education to students and teachers, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Protecting Kids from  
5 Fentanyl Act of 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. USE OF PREVENTIVE HEALTH AND HEALTH SERV-**  
2 **ICES BLOCK GRANTS TO PURCHASE LIFE-**  
3 **SAVING OPIOID ANTAGONISTS FOR SCHOOLS**  
4 **AND TO PROVIDE RELATED TRAINING AND**  
5 **EDUCATION TO STUDENTS AND TEACHERS.**

6 Section 1904(a)(1) of the Public Health Service Act  
7 (42 U.S.C. 300w-3(a)(1)) is amended—

8 (1) by redesignating subparagraphs (F) and  
9 (G) as (I) and (J), respectively;

10 (2) By inserting after subparagraph (E) the fol-  
11 lowing:

12 “(F) Purchasing naloxone or other opioid antagonists  
13 for use in educational institutions.

14 “(G) Providing training to school nurses, teachers,  
15 school administrators, and school resource officers on how  
16 to administer naloxone or other opioid antagonists.

17 “(H) Providing fentanyl awareness classes or mate-  
18 rials to students.”; and

19 (3) in each of subparagraphs (I) and (J), as re-  
20 designated, by striking “(A) through (F)” and in-  
21 serting “(A) through (H)”.
