Mr. PASTOR of Arizona introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on the Judiciary

A BILL

For the relief of Alfredo Ramirez Vasquez.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. WAIVER OF GROUNDS FOR REMOVAL OF, OR**
4 **DENIAL OF ADMISSION TO, ALFREDO RAMI-**
5 **REZ VASQUEZ.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding sections 212(a)
7 and 237(a) of the Immigration and Nationality Act,
8 Alfredo Ramirez Vasquez may not be removed from the
9 United States, or denied admission to the United States,
10 by reason of any act of his that is a ground for removal
11 or denial of admission and is reflected in the records of
12 the Department of Homeland Security, or the Visa Office

1 of the Department of State, on the date of the enactment
2 of this Act.

3 (b) RESCISSION OF OUTSTANDING ORDER OF RE-
4 MOVAL.—The Secretary of Homeland Security shall re-
5 scind any outstanding order of removal, or any finding of
6 inadmissibility or deportability, that has been entered
7 against Alfredo Ramirez Vasquez by reason of any act de-
8 scribed in subsection (a).

9 (c) ESTABLISHMENT OF GOOD MORAL CHAR-
10 ACTER.—Notwithstanding section 101(f) of the Immigra-
11 tion and Nationality Act, any act described in subsection
12 (a) may not be considered in determining whether Alfredo
13 Ramirez Vasquez is, or during any period has been, a per-
14 son of good moral character for purposes of the Immigra-
15 tion and Nationality Act.
