(a) ADDITIONAL CATEGORY OF ORPHANS.—The Sec-4 5 retary of Homeland Security shall expand the humani-6 tarian parole policy for certain Haitian orphans an-7 nounced on January 18, 2010, so as to apply it, on a case-8 by-case basis as determined appropriate by the Secretary, 9 to children who were legally confirmed as orphans eligible 10 for intercountry adoption by the Government of Haiti before January 12, 2010. 11

(b) SAFE AND SECURE PLACEMENTS.—Placement of
children granted humanitarian parole into the United
States pursuant to the parole policy referred to in subsection (a) may include placement in an Unaccompanied
Refugee Minor program, pursuant to section 412(d) of the
Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1522(d)), if
a suitable family member is not available to provide care.
