3 **SECTION 1. TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON MEDICAL DE-**
4 **VICE EXCISE TAX.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subsection (c) of section 4191 of
6 the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by striking
7 “2017” and inserting “2022”.

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendments made by
2 this section shall apply to sales after December 31, 2017.

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
