Mr. GRAVES of Missouri introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Homeland Security

A BILL

To prohibit the obligation of funds to pay the salary of the Secretary of Homeland Security until a biometric entry and exit data system has been fully implemented, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Preventing Illegal Visa
5 Overstays Act of 2016”.

1 **SEC. 2. NO PAYMENT OF SALARY TO THE SECRETARY OF**
2 **HOMELAND SECURITY UNTIL FULL IMPLE-**
3 **MENTATION OF THE ENTRY AND EXIT DATA**
4 **SYSTEM.**

5 Beginning on the date of enactment of this Act, no
6 funds made available in any fiscal year may be obligated
7 to pay the salary of the Secretary of Homeland Security.
8 The limitation provided under the previous sentence shall
9 no longer apply beginning on the date that the entry and
10 exit data system (as such term is defined in section
11 7208(b) of the Intelligence Reform and Terrorism Preven-
12 tion Act of 2004 (8 U.S.C. 1365b(b))) has been fully im-
13 plemented.
