A BILL

To make opioid treatment programs eligible for grants under section 2008 of the Social Security Act.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Opioid Treatment Pro-
5 viders Act”.

6 **SEC. 2. ELIGIBILITY OF OPIOID TREATMENT PROGRAMS**
7 **FOR HEALTH PROFESSIONS OPPORTUNITY**
8 **GRANTS.**

9 Section 2008(a)(4)(A) of the Social Security Act (42
10 U.S.C. 1397g(a)(4)(A)) is amended by striking “or a com-

1 munity-based organization” and inserting “, a community-
2 based organization, or an opioid treatment program (as
3 defined in section 1861(jjj)(2)) and other high quality
4 comprehensive addiction care providers”.

5 **SEC. 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

6 The amendment made by this Act shall take effect
7 on October 1, 2023.

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
