To suspend temporarily the duty on certain non-toric shaped polarized materials of 80 mm or less in diameter.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. NON-TORIC SHAPED POLARIZED MATERIALS**

4 **OF MORE THAN 80 MM IN DIAMETER.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:

“	9902.01.00	Polarized lenses, lens blanks, wafers, sheets or plates consisting of polyvinyl alcohol (PVA) and polycarbonate to be used in the production of lenses for sunglasses, not toric-shaped, with an outer profile diameter of 80 mm or less (provided for in subheadings 9001.20.00, 9001.50.00, or 9001.90.90)	Free	No change	No change	On or before 12/31/2015	”.

1 (b) **EFFECTIVE DATE.**—The amendment made by
2 subsection (a) applies to goods entered, or withdrawn from
3 warehouse for consumption, on or after the 15th day after
4 the date of the enactment of this Act.
