## A BILL

To modify the boundaries of Cibola National Forest in the State of New Mexico, to transfer certain Bureau of Land Management land for inclusion in the national forest, and for other purposes.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,

SECTION 1. BOUNDARY MODIFICATION AND TRANSFER OF

ADMINISTRATIVE JURISDICTION, CIBOLA NATIONAL FOREST, NEW MEXICO.

(a) BOUNDARY MODIFICATION.—

The boundaries of Cibola

National Forest in the State of New Mexico, are

- 1 modified to include the land depicted for such inclu-2 sion on the Forest Service map titled "Crest of Mon-
- 3 tezuma Proposed Land Transfer" and dated October
- 4 26, 2009.
- 5 (2) AVAILABILITY AND CORRECTION OF MAP.—
- 6 The map referred to in paragraph (1) shall be on
- file and available for public inspection in the appro-
- 8 priate offices of the Forest Service. The Chief of the
- 9 Forest Service may make technical and clerical cor-
- rections to the map.
- 11 (b) Transfer of Bureau of Land Management
- 12 Land.—
- 13 (1) Transfer.—The Secretary of the Interior
- shall transfer to the administrative jurisdiction of
- 15 the Secretary of the Agriculture, for inclusion in,
- and administration as part of, Cibola National For-
- est, the public land administered by the Bureau of
- 18 Land Management and identified as the "Crest of
- Montezuma" on the map referred to in subsection
- 20 (a).
- 21 (2) Effect of transfer on existing per-
- 22 MITS.—In the case of any permit or other land use
- authorization for public land transferred under para-
- graph (1) that is still in effect as of the transfer
- date, the Secretary of Agriculture shall administer

- 1 the permit or other land use authorization according
- 2 to the terms of the permit or other land use author-
- 3 ization. Upon expiration of such a permit or author-
- 4 ization, the Secretary of Agriculture may reauthorize
- 5 the use covered by the permit or authorization under
- 6 authorities available to the Secretary on such terms
- 7 and conditions as the Secretary considers in the
- 8 public interest.
- 9 (c) Land Acquisition Authority.—Subject to the
- 10 appropriation of funds to carry out this subsection and
- 11 the consent of the owner of private land included within
- 12 the boundaries of Cibola National Forest by subsection
- 13 (a), the Secretary of Agriculture may acquire the private
- 14 land.
- 15 (d) Management of Acquired Land.—
- 16 (1) Management.—Any federally owned lands
- that have been or hereafter may be acquired for Na-
- tional Forest System purposes within the boundaries
- of Cibola National Forest, as modified by subsection
- 20 (a), shall be managed as lands acquired under the
- Act of March 1, 1911 (commonly known as the
- Weeks Act; 16 U.S.C. 515 et seq.), and in accord-
- ance with the other laws and regulations pertaining
- to the National Forest System.

1	(2) WITHDRAWAL FROM MINING AND CERTAIN
2	OTHER USES.—The land depicted on the map re-
3	ferred to in subsection (a) and acquired by the Sec-
4	retary of Agriculture is hereby withdrawn from—
5	(A) all forms of entry, appropriation, or
6	disposal under the public land laws;
7	(B) location, entry, and patent under the
8	public land mining laws; and
9	(C) operation of the mineral leasing and
10	geothermal leasing laws and the mineral mate-
11	rials laws.
12	(e) Relation to Land and Water Conservation
13	FUND ACT.—For purposes of section 7 of the Land and
14	Water Conservation Fund Act of 1965 (16 U.S.C. 460l–
15	9), the boundaries of Cibola National Forest, as modified
16	by subsection (a), shall be considered to be boundaries of
17	the Cibola National Forest as of January 1, 1965.
