A BILL

For the relief of Michael Janssen and Steven Passantino.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER RETIREMENT**
4 **BENEFITS FOR MICHAEL JANSSEN AND STE-**
5 **VEN PASSANTINO.**

6 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
7 sion of law, Michael Janssen and Steven Passantino shall,
8 during any period they are employed as series 1895 offi-
9 cers of the U.S. Customs and Border Protection before,
10 on, or after the date of enactment of this Act, be deemed
11 to be performing service as a law enforcement officer (as
12 that term is defined in section 8401 of title 5, United

1 States Code) under chapter 84 of such title, and shall be
2 subject to the terms and conditions applicable under such
3 chapter to such officers.

4 (b) CREDITABLE SERVICE; DEPOSIT.—Any cred-
5 itable service performed before the date of enactment of
6 this Act by Michael Janssen and Steven Passantino under
7 such chapter 84 as such series 1895 officers shall be
8 deemed to be service as such a law enforcement officer,
9 but only if they meet the deposit requirements of section
10 8411(f) of such title 5 with respect to such service.
