## A BILL

To direct the Secretary of Energy to review and update a report on the energy and environmental benefits of the re-refining of used lubricating oil.

1       *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2       *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3       **SECTION 1. ENERGY SAVINGS FROM LUBRICATING OIL.**

4       Not later than one year after the date of enactment  
5       of this Act, the Secretary of Energy, in cooperation with  
6       the Administrator of the Environmental Protection Agen-  
7       cy and the Director of Management and Budget, shall—

8               (1) review and update the report prepared pur-  
9       suant to section 1838 of the Energy Policy Act of  
10       2005;

1           (2) after consultation with relevant Federal,  
2           State, and local agencies and affected industry and  
3           stakeholder groups, update data that was used in  
4           preparing that report; and

5           (3) prepare and submit to Congress a coordi-  
6           nated Federal strategy to increase the beneficial  
7           reuse of used lubricating oil, that—

8                   (A) is consistent with national policy as es-  
9                   tablished pursuant to section 2 of the Used Oil  
10                  Recycling Act of 1980 (Public Law 96–463);  
11                  and

12                  (B) addresses measures needed to—

13                          (i) increase the responsible collection  
14                          of used oil;

15                          (ii) disseminate public information  
16                          concerning sustainable reuse options for  
17                          used oil; and

18                          (iii) promote sustainable reuse of used  
19                          oil by Federal agencies, recipients of Fed-  
20                          eral grant funds, entities contracting with  
21                          the Federal Government, and the general  
22                          public.
