3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Healthy Babies Act
5 of 2023”.

1 **SEC. 2. INFANT FOOD COMBINATIONS AND DINNERS**
2 **UNDER WIC.**

3 Section 17 of the Child Nutrition Act of 1966 (42
4 U.S.C. 1786) is amended by adding at the end the fol-
5 lowing:

6 “(t) **INFANT FOOD COMBINATIONS AND DINNERS.**—
7 Not later than 1 year after the date of the enactment of
8 this subsection, the Secretary shall update the regulations
9 prescribed pursuant to subsection (f)(11)(A) to amend the
10 supplemental foods available to include infant food com-
11 binations and dinners.”.

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
