1 **SECTION 1. ION-EXCHANGE RESIN OF BENZENE,**
 2 **DIETHENYL, POLYMER WITH**
 3 **ETHENYLBENZENE AND**
 4 **ETHENYLETHYLBENZENE,**
 5 **CHLOROMETHYLATED,**
 6 **TRIMETHYLAMINOQUATERNIZED.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
 8 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
 9 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
 10 new heading:
