3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Zero Tolerance for Ille-
5 gal Entry Act”.

1 **SEC. 2. ZERO TOLERANCE REGARDING ILLEGAL ENTRY OF-**
2 **OFFENSES.**

3 The Attorney General shall establish a policy for the
4 Department of Justice requiring all United States attor-
5 neys to prosecute offenses under sections 275 and 276 of
6 the Immigration and Nationality Act (8 U.S.C. 1325,
7 1326) to the fullest extent possible.
