Mr. STEUBE introduced the following bill; which was referred to the Committee on Foreign Affairs

A BILL

To direct the Assistant Secretary of State for Consular Affairs to notify United States citizens regarding passport expiration and renewal, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Passport Notification
5 Act of 2023”.

6 **SEC. 2. REQUIRED NOTIFICATION REGARDING PASSPORT**
7 **EXPIRATION AND RENEWAL.**

8 (a) REQUIREMENT.—For each United States citizen
9 in possession of a valid unexpired passport, not later than

1 180 days prior to the date on which such passport is
2 scheduled to expire, the Assistant Secretary of State for
3 Consular Affairs shall provide to the United States cit-
4 izen—

5 (1) a notification regarding such pending expi-
6 ration date; and

7 (2) information on the process for the renewal
8 of such passport, including an identification of any
9 relevant locations at which materials required for
10 such renewal may be submitted.

11 (b) FORM.—Each notification required under sub-
12 section (a) may be submitted in electronic or paper form.

13 (c) APPLICABILITY.—The requirement under sub-
14 section (a) shall apply with respect to passports the expi-
15 ration of which is scheduled to occur on or after the date
16 that is 180 days after the date of the enactment of this
17 Act.
