A BILL

To amend the Small Business Act to adjust the employment size standard requirements for determining whether a manufacturing concern is a small business concern, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Capturing All Small
5 Businesses Act of 2019”.

6 **SEC. 2. EMPLOYMENT SIZE STANDARD REQUIREMENTS.**

7 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 3(a)(2) of the Small Busi-
8 ness Act (15 U.S.C. 632(a)(2)) is amended—

1 (1) in subparagraph (A), by inserting “and sub-
2 ject to the requirements specified under subpara-
3 graph (C)” after “paragraph (1)”; and

4 (2) in subparagraph (C)—

5 (A) by inserting “(including the Adminis-
6 tration when acting pursuant to subparagraph
7 (A))” after “no Federal department or agency”;
8 and

9 (B) in clause (ii)(I) by striking “12
10 months” and inserting “24 months”.

11 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—This Act and the amend-
12 ments made by this Act shall take effect one year after
13 the date of the enactment of this Act.
